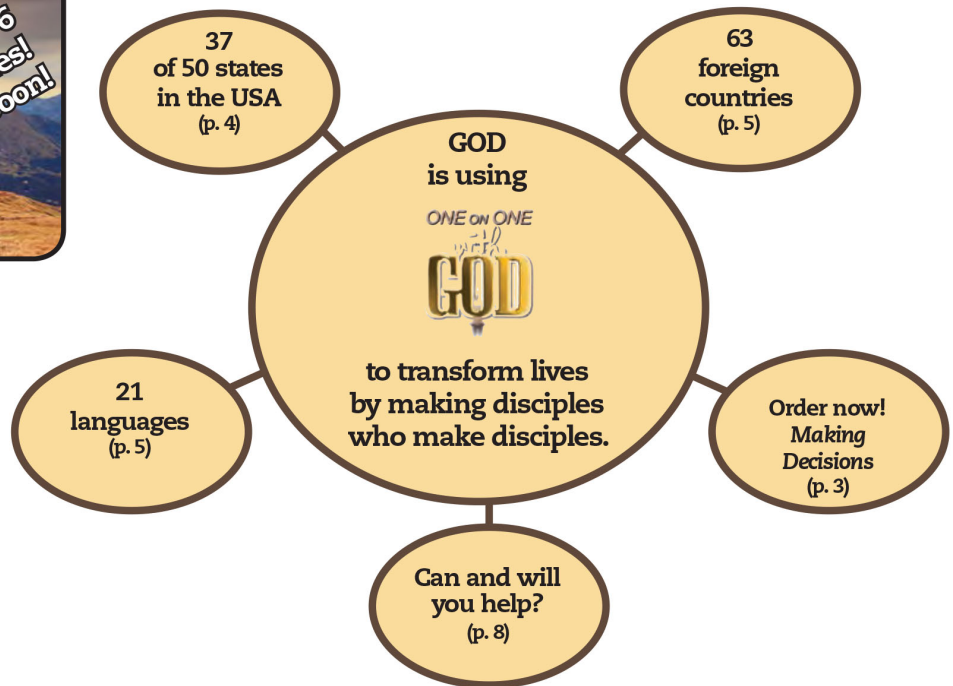
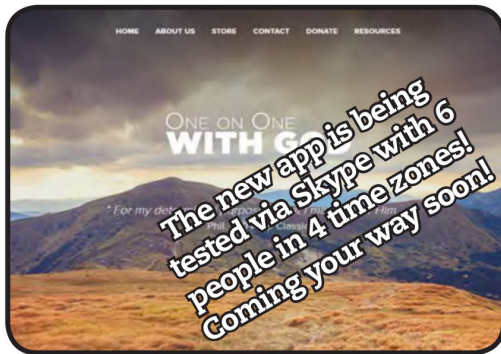

One on One with God has given our church the missing tool to truly make disciples in a practical and transformational way. We have been strong historically in making converts and then hoped they would grow as disciples by plugging into church and small groups, but this has fallen short of God's glory in making disciples.

I've seen *One on One with God* take a young man who recently became a Christian—with no Bible knowledge at all—transform into a fully devoted follower of Jesus Christ. He is now married to his estranged girlfriend, who is mother of their three children, and he is discipling his wife and oldest child even though he has only been a Christian for six months.

One other man I am taking through *One on One* has been a Christian for more than 30 years but was never discipled. He is an extremely influential businessman who has built an insurance company employing hundreds of agents. Every year the agency hosts a training event with over 800 in attendance. They present the gospel and desperately needed a discipleship strategy. He now has *One on One with God* that will spread around the entire state of Oklahoma.

Before *One on One with God*, I did not have an intimate acquaintance with God, much less an intimate relationship and fellowship. Through *One on One with God*, I've found that purpose. 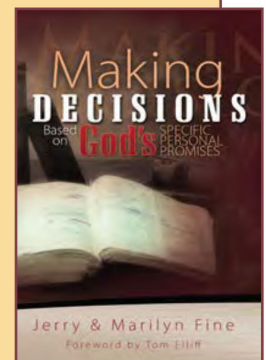

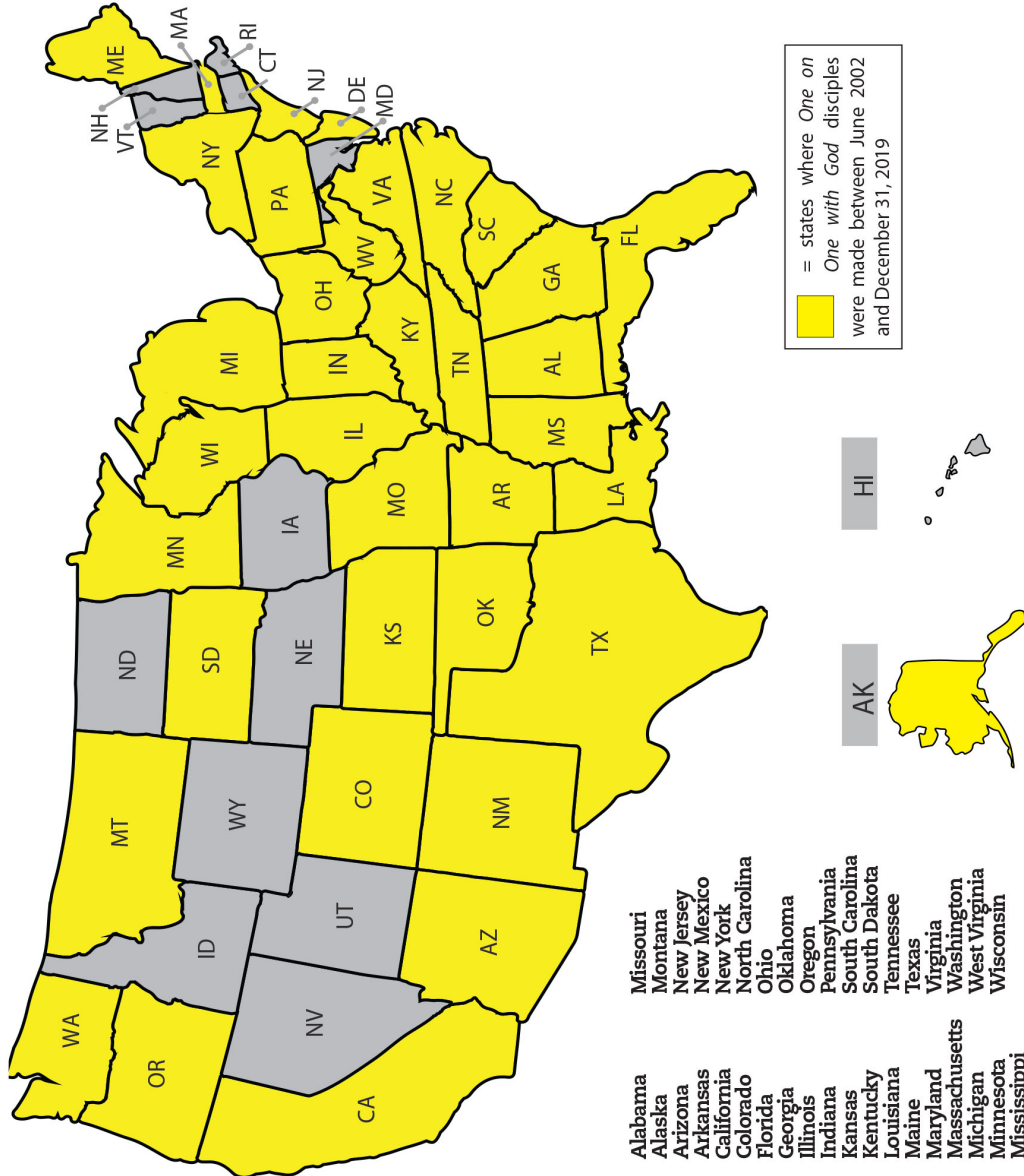

37 states where *One on One with God* disciples were made between June 2002 and December 31, 2019



In 1975 our pastor Charles Tope visited us and asked us to make disciples at church like we were in our home. He explained that we needed to make *One on One with God* available to more people than we were able to disciple in our home. We agreed and began making disciples and producing disciple-makers both at home and at church.

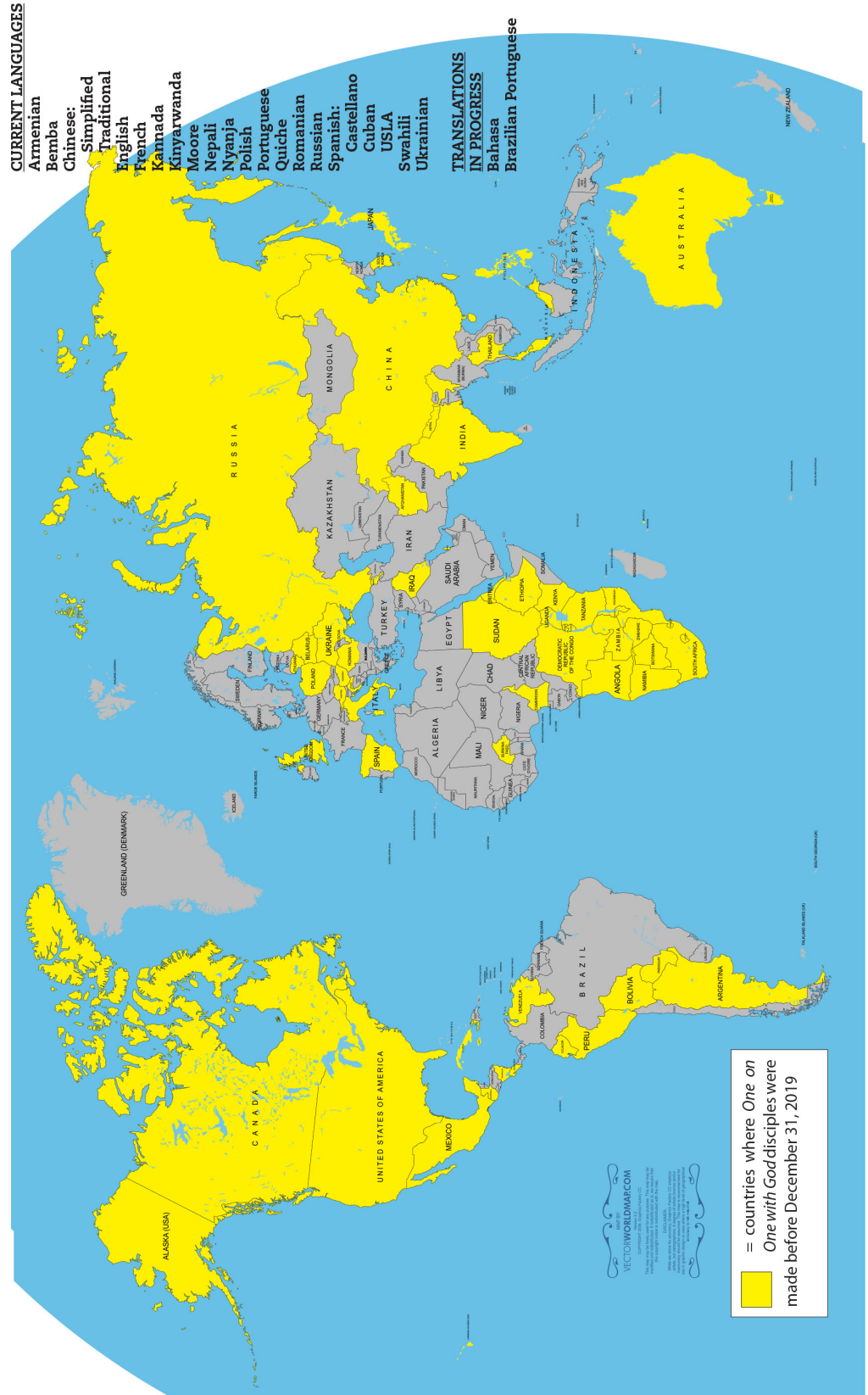
Over the years the loose-leaf *One on One with God* notebooks became the professionally printed and bound workbooks that are in use today. In 2002 we invested in a website that made it possible for people to order *One on One with God* books online, which allowed us to keep a record of where the books were being shipped.

Our records from 1970 to 2002 are not sufficient to share with you the number of states where we had disciple-makers, but in the 17 years between 2002 and 2019, we have proof of *One on One with God* disciple-makers in 37 states and hundreds of locations. **Those who have been reached heard about *One on One* from concerned friends and relatives who wanted to share with someone they loved what they had learned through being disciplined using the tool *One on One with God*.**

A REPORT ON 2019 IN AFRICA

from H [REDACTED] Zambia

We celebrate what God has done this year through Go Face to Face and *One on One with God* in Zambia and beyond. We are very grateful to our incredible partners who have dedicated their lives to making disciples and disciple-makers and others who have provided financial and prayer support for our work. There is great need for more *One on One* books, study Bibles, and regular Bibles for our brothers and sisters in Africa. We are praying for you and look forward to a blessed 2020.

WITH A MOVEMENT COME CHALLENGES

Kenya & South Sudan (February 1-15)

As we planned our two-nation disciple-making trip to Kenya and South Sudan, Elder [REDACTED] and I prayed constantly for God's direction in light of recent Islamic attacks in Kenya and ethnic/civil strife in South Sudan. On February 21, Kenya's Ministry of Foreign Affairs issued an advisory, warning its citizens against travel to parts of South Sudan affected by conflict. But the love of God, fellow Christians, and the lost compelled us to go to South Sudan despite the advisory.

We held a five-day training at N [REDACTED] Church in [REDACTED] Kenya, where Pastor E [REDACTED] and Brother [REDACTED] did an excellent job as translators for us. We traveled 15 km round trip to the training each day on motorbikes known as *Boda-boda*; we enjoyed this experience because neither of us had ever ridden a motorbike. Many disciples traveled up to 20 km on motorbikes to attend. Their love and passion for the Lord and the training were amazing.



To allow all who came to participate, we taught for 16 to 21 hours each day because most disciples were peasant farmers and could

only attend in the evenings. On the first day we had 54 participants, but more people showed up the next day. Even with a limited number of books, we turned no one away and allowed those without books to listen or read aloud from a shared book during the sessions.

Ten different denominations were represented in our sessions, including 30 pastors and 40 key leaders.

On the second day in Kenya, two Muslim men attended. They returned each day, and as we taught, we saw them



move from the back of the building toward the front and change from frowning and not understanding to smiling and praising God. The local pastor has told us that the duo are now willing to learn more about Jesus, and he is helping lead them to salvation. Please pray for these men who could be a huge influence in winning other Muslims to Christ.

South Sudan in eastern Africa is a country where Christians are persecuted. The population of 10 to 12 million people has been ravaged by civil war, and many people have died or been displaced. The country is hard to reach, and its people feel isolated and forgotten. Hungry for encouragement from other believers, the disciples were



very glad we had come to equip and pray with them.

Our time in South Sudan was challenging. At the international airport in Juba, an immigration

official demanded a shocking \$100-per-day fee in order to conduct the training. God intervened, and we were given entry after paying \$100 for books. On our five-hour road trip from Juba to Torit, we were stopped three times by armed soldiers and policemen who searched us and scrutinized our bags filled with *One on One* books.

The *One on One* training lasted just three days to give us enough time to exit the country. Thirty-two people attended the first day, but that number doubled on the second day, and we ended up training a total of 76 people. Our local coordinator [REDACTED] left his family in a refugee camp in Uganda and has worked tirelessly in South Sudan to re-establish churches destroyed or abandoned in the civil war.

South Africa-Lesotho-Swaziland (September 7-28)

We traveled to South Africa, Lesotho, and Swaziland to meet key disciple-makers and help them develop/manage teams. Dedicated disciple-makers we had trained on a previous visit partnered with us in teaching new groups, giving them hands-on opportunity to learn to handle intensive training sessions. We dedicated a full day to discussing the introductory parts of the leader's guide, which allowed us to answer questions, share experiences and concerns, and receive face-to-face feedback from those we had trained. Thanks to your support, on this trip we were able to deliver 300 *One on One* workbooks and 150 leader's guides to local leadership teams.

We did face challenges on this trip. One week before we traveled to South Africa, we saw disturbing media reports showing xenophobic violence in various cities in that country. People were waving fighting sticks and improvised spears and shields as they advanced like armies through the streets chanting, "Foreigners must go back to where they came from." They were also looting and burning shops and attacking and killing foreigners.



We know that a nation can only be healed and this kind of violence stopped when its people accept Jesus Christ as Lord of their lives. This conviction enabled us to encourage our brothers and sisters to continue spreading the Good News and making disciples who will make disciples.

In **South Africa** we partnered with local leaders to train 23 new disciple-makers at Evangelistic International Church in Durban. We also worked with over 60 disciple-makers in Kwa Mashu, a crime-ridden shanty township where a new church had been planted using *One on One* as a disciple-making/evangelism tool. God is at work in this hard-to-reach community, and the church, which began with 15 new believers, has grown to a membership of 93 in 18 months.



In Maseru, **Lesotho**, we taught two streams over six days: one during the day and another in the evening for those working and in school. God continues to work with the *One on One* team there, and the movement is now reaching other towns. We met people who had traveled from remote areas of Lesotho to share stories of how *One on One* has helped churches reinvigorate their discipleship.

From Lesotho we traveled to Mbabane, **Swaziland**, and again conducted two streams per day. As it had in 2017, [REDACTED] Church hosted the training. During the afternoon we met with local pastors and leaders to share the purpose of our trip. It was very encouraging to learn that the 56 people we had trained in 2017 had produced 26 disciples. This year we trained 67 new disciple-makers.

ONE ON ONE PARTNERS WITH JESUS FILM *Jesus film/EPI partnership (November-December)*

In eastern **Zambia** we partnered with Evangelism Partners International (EPI), which asked us to assist with disciple-making as they plant churches and use the *One on One* resource tools. EPI has stepped up their evangelism program by equipping believers with *Jesus film* kits. Zambian EPI leaders invited our disciple-makers from southern and eastern Africa to travel to Zambia for training in using these kits. EPI covered transportation, accommodations, food, and other costs, and Go Face to Face provided *One on One* books.



Seven *One on One* leaders from Zimbabwe, South Africa, Lesotho, Swaziland, Tanzania, Malawi, and Mozambique came to Zambia for the *Jesus film* training, which gave us an opportunity to print some *One on One* books for our friends to take with them. To help plant churches with disciple-making DNA, each leader went home with a state-of-the-art backpack containing a small projector, battery, speakers, and tents. Hundreds of people are receiving Christ through watching the *Jesus film*, and church planters are discipling these new believers using *One on One*. This initiative has been very effective in Tanzania, Mozambique, Namibia, Zimbabwe, Botswana, and Zambia.



Eastern Province, Zambia (October 7-13)

At the invitation of the Eastern Province Baptist Association, I traveled to meetings with our disciple-makers from Zambia, Malawi, and Mozambique. It was encouraging to see these brethren continue to be faithful and obedient to the call to make disciples. In working with local churches, these disciple-makers have helped many people understand how to become a Christian, and 63 people were baptized by our disciple-makers on Sunday, October 13. These new believers will now learn to be disciple-makers using *One on One with God*.



Zambia

Zambia is the African hub and launch pad for the *One on One with God* disciple-making ministry, and since 2008 thousands of people have been disciplined using this tool. Several churches have adopted *One on One* as their main training resource for disciple-making leadership teams. We have received very positive feedback from areas we haven't visited—and we have no idea how *One on One* got there! The ministry has grown so much that it is now difficult to track the numbers of people being disciplined.

There are still many unreached locations we intend to visit, including Luapula Province, Zambia, an area where many people's livelihood is fishing. Sadly, most of these people rely on witchcraft and ancestral worship, which they believe brings success in their trade. The fields are ripe in these areas to turn these fishermen into fishers of men.

KEY LEADER'S SEMINAR IN LUSAKA 2020

We are praying that in 2020 we can conduct at least one key leaders' seminar in Lusaka, which will equip disciple-makers from the African countries where *One on One* is being used as a tool.

THE MOVEMENT DEMANDS MORE BOOKS

In 2019 we continued printing more *One on One with God* books to keep our disciple-makers equipped to produce more disciples. Languages printed included English, Swahili, Nyanja, Bemba, and French. The need for more *One on One* books has been a great challenge, and as the movement in Africa grows, so does the demand for books.



God is at work in Asia through *One on One with God*

One of our dear friends and partners in Asia says, "It is a privilege to serve the Lord using *One on One with God* in restricted and often remote, poor areas." For many years this humble partner has enabled pastors to stay on the field, preach the gospel, and minister to the local people by giving each pastor a cow, pigs, or chickens so he can support his family by selling or trading milk, piglets, or eggs. This is just one act of love and compassion by our *One on One* partner, who is a well educated servant who sits on many boards and is a guest speaker teaching *One on One* in several seminaries.

One of the joys of 2019 for our partner was personally discipling a CEO and his wife in an unrestricted area. After five weeks the CEO's wife joined in going through *One on One with God* because she had seen drastic changes in her husband. Now the CEO and his wife are bringing many people to Christ and have a passion to see the transformation of lives into the likeness of Christ.

Referring to one restricted area, our *One on One with God* partner, says:

- "To date we have printed 4,000 *One on One* workbooks and 4,000 leader's guides. Once these books are distributed in the field, recipients print duplicate copies that are then used in many places unknown to me. All these *One on One* books are given away at no cost to those disciplined, and the disciples are challenged to use the books to make disciples who will make disciples.
- "Transporting the books in bulk is becoming more difficult due to security issues, so we're teaching disciples to use the books in creative ways. Most simply use the books to make disciples who will make disciples. Others use them for preaching and making disciples in their congregations. Still others use them to orally teach peasants and older folks in farming areas or to teach baptism classes. All these methods are creating a greater hunger for *One on One with God*!" **TO GOD BE THE GLORY!**

AN IMPORTANT LETTER

In 2019 missiologists identified 707 movements of God worldwide where disciples are making disciple-making disciples and churches are multiplying to the fourth generation in at least four streams of multiplication. We do not know if *One on One with God* was considered in that study, but we do know that when you invest financially in *One on One*, **for every two Africans disciplined with our materials, one will reproduce and make more disciples.**



***One on One with God* is a fantastic kingdom investment!**

We urge you to ask God how you can be part of what He is doing in Africa and worldwide by investing in *One on One*.

AN URGENT NEED IN 2019: For the first time we were unable to provide the necessary funds to fully support the *One on One with God* disciple-making movements. Between 1970 and 2002, we were personally able to fund all that was needed. Between 2002 and 2018, others joined us to meet the necessary funding, but in 2019 we fell short in fully funding all that we needed to do.

Now we are asking you to join us in specifically asking the Father to provide the financial resources to support these disciple-making movements and to prayerfully consider giving generously. While we are confident that God will provide, we are also aware of the requirement to educate you as to the need.

Meeting the challenge at our doorsteps will require a nearly threefold increase in gifts to *One on One with God*. Our specific requests are for you to support us prayerfully, give as God leads, and serve as God directs.
